



Veterinary Herbal Training

Terms and conditions for VHT Courses

All delegates must be registered MRCVS or RVNs. (Or equivalent if outside the UK)

Foundation Course:

The fee includes twenty-four hours of CPD; a set of course notes; any herbal supplies needed for practical sessions; first year membership to BAVH (British Association of Veterinary Herbalists), support and further information.

This is a practical course, so herbal preparations will be tasted and handled throughout. These do contain different herbs and varying concentrations of alcohol. As with any medicine and/or plant there is a small risk of allergic reactions, drug interactions. If this is a concern to you, please contact us to discuss things further. If you are pregnant or have any health conditions that you think may be affected, please let us know.

If registration numbers are not sufficient for the course to run, delegates will be informed within two weeks of the date of the start of the course and fees will be returned in full. VHT can accept no responsibility for any other costs incurred.

The fee is non-refundable, but in the case of sickness or inability to attend any part of the course, transfers may be made to another course for that part missed.

12 Month Subscription Course:

The fee includes up to eight hours of CPD; this is dependent on the delegate attending the live sessions.

It includes access to video lectures, PDF copies of notes, the opportunity to join 3 live, online sessions over the course of the year.

If you intend to try any of the herbs presented on this course, please remember that, as with any medicine and/or plant there is a small risk of allergic reactions, drug interactions and that tinctures do contain alcohol.

The fee is non-refundable. It is the delegates responsibility to attend the live sessions; these are not transferable or refundable if you are unable to attend.
